Responsibility	Description
Implementation of Digital Systems	Introduce and maintain e-governance tools and systems such as online admission, examination management, and grievance handling.
Automation of Administrative Processes	Automate processes like fee payments, attendance tracking, results publication, and document requests to save time and reduce errors.
Development of Online Portals	Develop and manage portals where students, faculty, and staff can access academic information, administrative services, and institutional updates.
