Responsibility	Description
Implement Reservation Policies	Ensure that the government-mandated reservations for admissions, scholarships, and job placements are properly followed.
Support Schemes and Scholarships	Facilitate access to scholarships, financial aid, and government welfare programs designed for SC/ST/OBC students.
Monitor Student Progress	Track the academic progress of students from SC, ST, and OBC backgrounds, identifying and addressing any challenges they face.
Provide Counseling and Mentoring	Offer academic, personal, and career guidance to help students overcome barriers and succeed in their studies.
Address Grievances and Complaints	Act as a forum for addressing the grievances, discrimination, or harassment faced by SC, ST, and OBC students.
Organize Awareness Programs	Conduct seminars, workshops, and awareness programs to educate the broader community about the issues faced by these groups.
Promote Social Integration	Foster an inclusive and harmonious environment by promoting interaction between students from diverse backgrounds.
Conduct Training for Faculty and Staff	Organize sensitization programs for faculty and staff to create a respectful and inclusive campus culture.
Encourage Leadership Development	Provide leadership opportunities for SC/ST/OBC students to take part in various student activities, including committees and councils.
