Speaking as a Chief guest at the Global Training & Placement Officers (TPO) Association & HR Leadership Excellence Summit 2025 organized by Telangana Training & Placement Officers Association in collaboration with All India TPO association New Delhi, held at T Hub on Friday Balakista Reddy said that there is no dearth of placement opportunities however it was imperative for education curriculum to be in sync with the industry needs and therefore chair...



Curriculum Must Prioritize Employment, Says Balakista Reddy

Highlighting the need to align education with industry requirements, Balakista Reddy, Chairman of Higher Education, Government of Telangana, urged educational institutions to update curricula to enhance employment opportunities. Speaking as the Chief Guest at the Global TPO & HR Leadership Excellence Summit 2025, organized by the Telangana Training & Placement Officers Association in collaboration with the All India TPO Association at T-Hub on Friday, he emphasized that India's youth must be equipped for careers ranging from deep-sea exploration to outer space.

Reddy noted that India is in

a transformational phase, moving from a developing to a developed nation and from an importer to an exporter. "With 65% of the population below 25, India's strength lies in its human capital. The next 22 years will be critical, and our youth must lead the nation," he said. Highlighting global interdependence and the impact of emerging technologies, he added that educationists and placement officers have a

pivotal role in preparing students to meet these challenges. Referring to the Maritime India Vision 2023, Reddy pointed out the ₹3 lakh crore investment and 20 lakh job opportunities in maritime, aviation, and space sectors. He stressed that curricula should equip students with relevant skills, and questioned whether enough institutions offer specialized aviation or space programs. The government is

addressing industry engagement through MOUs with leading companies and providing free English syllabus support for rural youth via tgche.ac.in. Guest of Honour Prof. Syed Aunul Hasan, Vice-Chancellor of Maulana Azad National Urdu University, urged a balance between tradition and modernity, while JNTU Registrar Venkateswarlu stressed the critical role of placement officers in connecting students with

Dr. Jayram, Vice-Chancellor of TTPOA, called for the formation of Training and Placement Cells as full-fledged units to enhance employment. The underscored the need for curriculum reform and proactive placement support to prepare Telangana youth for emerging global opportunities and strengthen India's position on the world stage.


